1. SCHEDULE OF RACES:

1.1 Except due to a general recall, no warning signal will be displayed after 16:30 on Saturdays or after 12:00 on Sundays.

2. THE MARKS

- a. Courses will use race marks as identified on the SCRA Racing Marks List <u>https://www.scra.org.uk/solent-marks/solent-marks2</u>
- b. Course announcements will be made on VHF Channel 37a and will use the 2-digit designations
- c. Fixed metal marks, inflatable laid marks and robotic 'Bot' Marks may all be used

3. START LINE

- 3.1 The Start Line for Round 3, Yarmouth may consist of; Committee Boat/Fixed Mark, Committee Boat/Robotic Mark, Robotic Mark/Fixed Mark and Shoreline/Fixed Mark Lines.
- 3.2 When a Committee Boat start is used the approximate position of the start line will be communicated on the event Whats App Group and on VHF Channel 37a
- 3.3 The Start Line for Race 1 shall be in the vicinity of the central Solent and will be communicated on the event Whats App Group and on VHF Channel 37a

4. FINISH LINE

4.1 Finish Lines shall consist of; Fixed Yacht Club Transit, Committee Boat/Fixed Mark, Committee Boat/ Robotic Mark, Robotic Mark/Fixed Mark and Shoreline/Fixed Mark Lines





- 4.2 Finish Line information will be communicated on the event Whats App Group and on VHF Channel 27a
- 4.3 Special Scoring Provisions CHANGING RRS 35, RRS A4.2 & RRS A9
 - a. In addition to RRS 32, when the Race Committee believe that boats are unlikely to finish within the time limit or boats do not finish within the time limit, they may score boats in the order, corrected on handicap if appropriate, that they passed through the last gate or mark at which the Race Committee are able to establish a finishing order. Such a line becomes the finishing line for those boats.
 - b. The Race Committee may signal this by the display of flag "S" and by announcement by VHF.
